United Way and the Alabama Department of Public Health are working together to provide assistance to individuals in Alabama, who are facing hardship resulting from the need to isolate due to COVID-19.

If you've tested positive for, or been exposed to, COVID-19, and are required to quarantine, you may qualify for assistance that could help keep your family safe and make isolation easier for you.

information and referral line, you can be screened to see if you may qualify for help in various ways, such as:



- Food from grocery stores and restaurants
- Short-term hotel accommodations
- Transportation to doctors and hospitals
- Laundry and cleaning supplies

These are just a few examples of ways you might receive assistance, but there are strict guidelines to qualify.
