CTE at Midfield High

At Midfield High School (MHS), students have the option to take advantage of Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs. On Campus are five CTE programs: Health Science, Business, AJROTC, Cosmetology and Fire Science. Off-campus CTE programs are offered by MHS partners in education and are as follows: Automotive Technology, HVAC, Building and Construction, Masonry, Welding, Logistics Training, and Electrical.

What's the CTE Buzz?

In Alabama, the Governor has partnered with business and industry leaders to develop a Career and Technical Education (CTE) Task Force. As a result, an Internship Initiative is underway to afford students the opportunities to earn wages during the summer, Christmas, and spring breaks. Interested MHS students will begin their training in CTE courses as early as the 10th grade with the potential to earn industry recognized credentials that range from certificates of completion to associate degrees by graduation. Upon program completion, some students will be employment with salaries beginning between \$14-\$16/hour. To sum it all, MHS CTE students will be college and career ready.

MHS Students and general education teachers have gone on company tours, made college campus visits, and toured the AIDT Workforce Training Center of downtown Birmingham, AL.
