Health & Safety

Precautions will be implemented including, but not limited to:

- Parents are requested to complete temperature checks prior to sending children to the school building. Students with a fever of 100.4 degrees or higher should not report to school. Students and staff should remain home if they are sick.
- Hand-sanitizing and hand-washing stations will be available throughout each school.
 Intensive cleaning will be completed throughout all buildings.
- Thoughtful group sizes that are feasible and practical in a school setting will be established.
- Signage will be posted in all buildings encouraging frequent hand washing and social distancing.
- Temperature checks will be conducted if a student demonstrates potential fever or other COVID-19 related symptoms. Students exhibiting symptoms will be quarantined and evaluated by the school nurse.

Wellness Monitoring

- Parents should notify the school nurse as soon as possible if their child is staying home from school due to COVID-19.
- In the case of a positive COVID-19 test of a student or staff member, school officials will follow current guidance of ADPH and the Alabama State Department of Education (ALSDE) regarding contact identification, notification, disinfecting of buildings, and potential campus closures.

Instruction Delivery

Students in grades K-12 will attend classes in a traditional, on-campus setting..

Mask

All students, employees and visitors must wear masks in MCS schools and facilities..

Quarantine

Every school in the Midfield School System will be required to have a designated quarantine area for students who become sick.

This area will be supervised and under the direction of the school nurse. Parents will be required to immediately report to the school to check their child out of school.

Transportation Services

School buses will operate normal and specialty routes in the same manner they did pre-Coviid.

Buses will be cleaned and sanitzed after morning and afternoon runs..

Cleaning & Sanitation

All schools, busses, and worksites within the school system will be sanitized daily.

Hand sanitizer will be provided throughout all schools and workplaces.

Drinking fountains will remain closed.
